








# Haute-Serre and the pond at Pinaud

# On the circuit of this hike, you will discover vernacular architecture characteristic of the daily life of the Creusois in the 19th century

This circuit is a summary of the characteristic landscapes of the eastern Creuse: farmland crisscrossed by hedges and trees, lively, pond. On the way, the local built heritage recalls the daily life of the Creusois in the 19th century

#### **Altimetric profile**




Min elevation 400 m Max elevation 468 m

- 1. Depart from the village of Haute-Serre. Go down into the village, continue along the road for 1 km.
- 2. Take the path on the right, follow it up to the four paths, take the second on the left.
- 3. Go along the edge of the pond at Pinaud, then, at the crossroads, turn left. Then, at the end of the path, turn left again, then right.
- 4. At the railway bridge, take the path to the right, then straight ahead, and, at the crossroads, take the track that goes up on the left to the road.
- 5. Take the path opposite, then at the road go left and go down the path on the right.
- 6. At the top of the wood, turn right and continue until you reach the village of Chassagne. Go through the village.
- 7. At the cross, take the road to the right, and then at the end of the village, the path on the left leads back to the village of Haute-Serre.
- 8. Turn right.

## On your path...



#### field henhouse (A)

Until the 1970s, this building, installed at the edge of the field, allowed farmers to feed poultry free of charge.
